LETTER FROM THE BOARD...

Hello Friends,

First and foremost, let me thank you for your continual support of the Sister Rebecca Berghoff Foundation. Our mission is as important today as it was yesterday: "...for the continuance of St. Joseph/Marquette Catholic School."

As you may recall, the Board of Directors decided to invest some money into the remolding of our Bingo Hall in Union Gap. We had not done that for a long time and the Board felt that it was long overdue and much needed to be competitive in the market. This past year the bingo income reached levels not seen in the past few years. The board now feels that the bingo operation will continue to be very profitable in the future. The next thing that has happened is the Layman family, which has owned the building and property where the bingo hall is located, notified us that they were ready to sell the buildings and property which included the bingo hall, a commercial laundromat, and a car wash. On April 30, 2014, the Foundation, after a thorough study, purchased the land and is sub-letting the Laundromat and carwash. The board projects this as a good investment and a protection of the present location for the continued operation of bingo.
